

RFP 029 Q&A

1. I[n] regards to the RFP, we were wondering what the RFP means by a physician being housed at the Brooklyn Treatment Court. Does this mean a FT Physic[i]an is required? A part time physic[i]an? Does the grant include funding for the physic[i]an? Or is this inclusive of the total award of \$500,433?

The RFP specifies that an “Addiction Medicine Physician to be housed at Brooklyn Treatment Court to conduct clinical assessments for all new MAT project participants...conducting MAT assessments and providing medication induction...responsible for medication monitoring and management throughout each participant’s treatment process” be included in the staffing plan and therefore the budget, but is not prescriptive about the percentage of full time this staff line must be budgeted. This element of the proposal is at the discretion of the proposer. To be clear, the position should be included within the maximum budget of \$500,433.

2. In Questions 9 and 12 the RFP references “technical support services”. Can you elaborate on what would be considered technical support services?

Technical support services would include preparing files, performing drug screens, gathering and inputting data and completing necessary paperwork.
