

# LIVE STREAMING

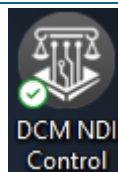
## User Guide

One of the enhancements introduced by the Division of Court Modernization is the capability to live stream proceedings directly from the courtroom.

The live streaming feature is currently limited to overflow rooms or judicial chambers, but select courtrooms are currently piloting internet streaming. Participation in the Internet streaming pilot requires approval from the courtroom’s presiding judge, the court’s Administrative or Supervising Judge, Chief Clerk, or District Executive.

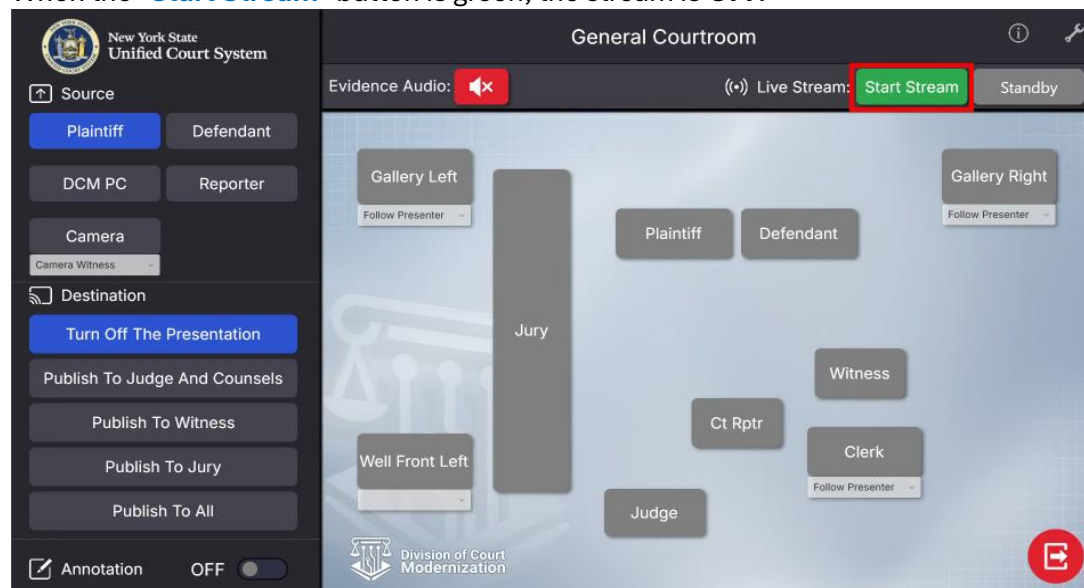
### Streaming from DCM NDI Control App



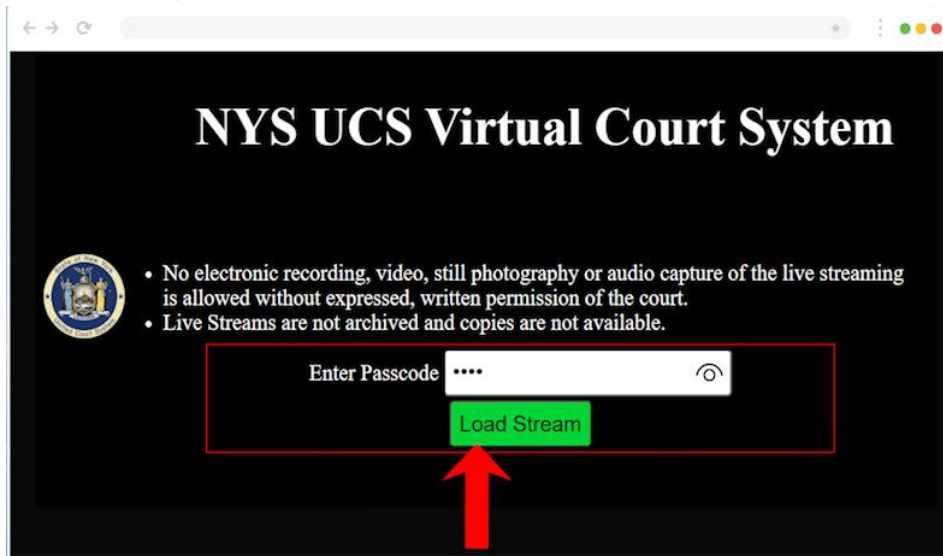
The stream is controlled by the DCM NDI control app.

The live Stream button is located at the top right edge of the control app.

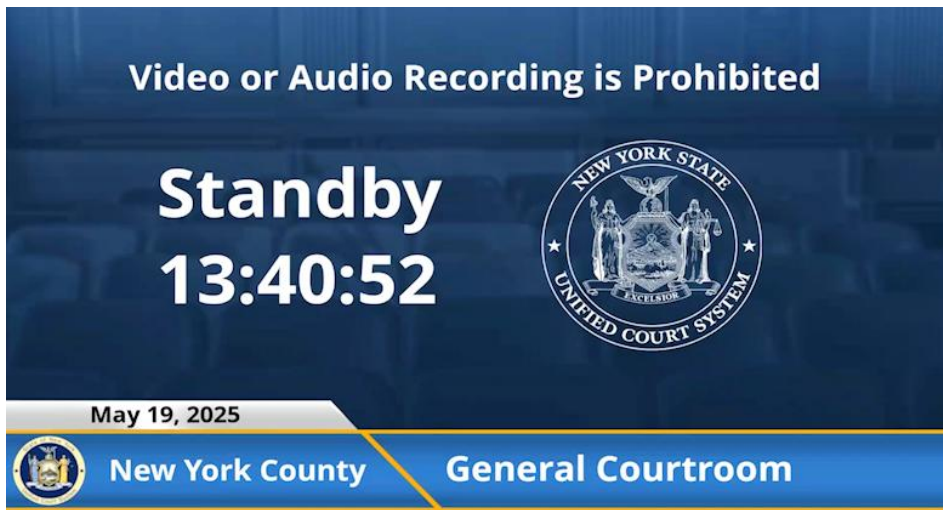
When the “**Start Stream**” button is green, the stream is **OFF**.



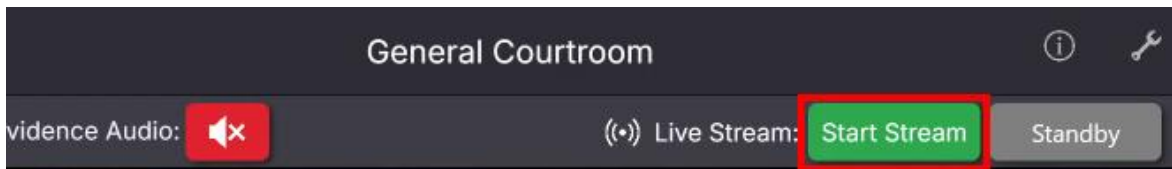
Upon logging into the stream with the supplied username and password, the user will be presented with a standby screen until the stream is live.



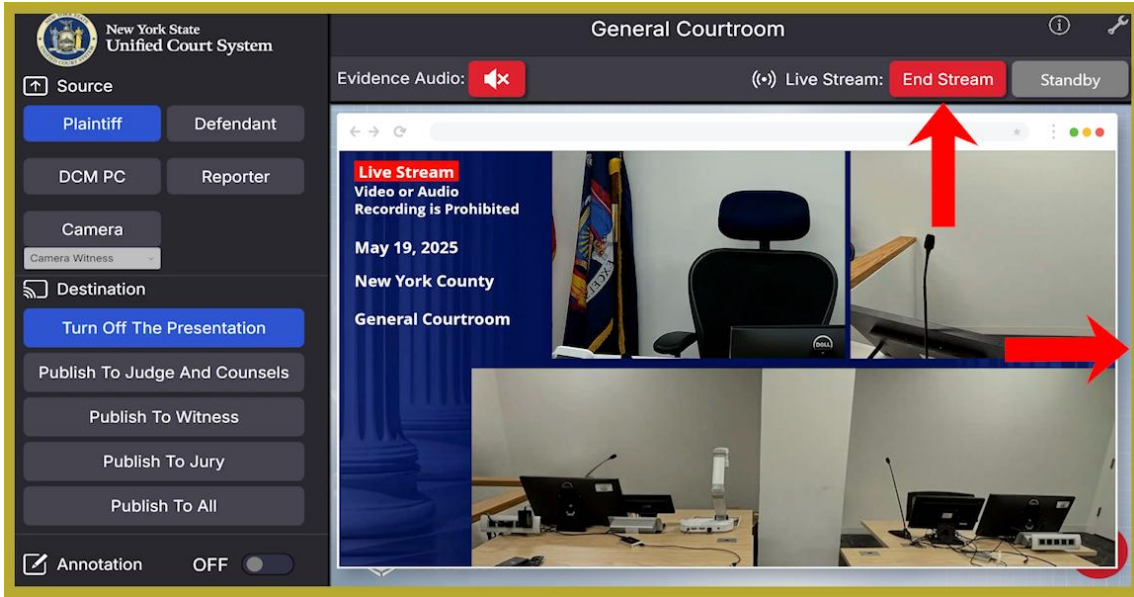
No audio or video is being transmitted while the stream is in standby mode.



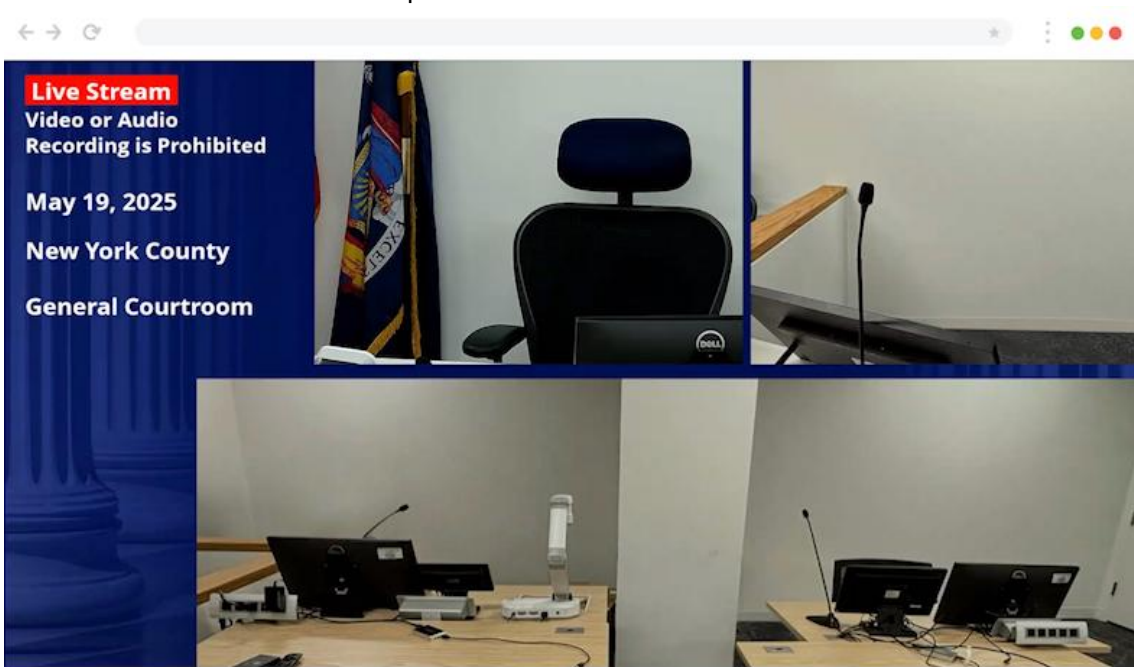
When you are ready to start the stream, click on the “**Start Stream**” button.



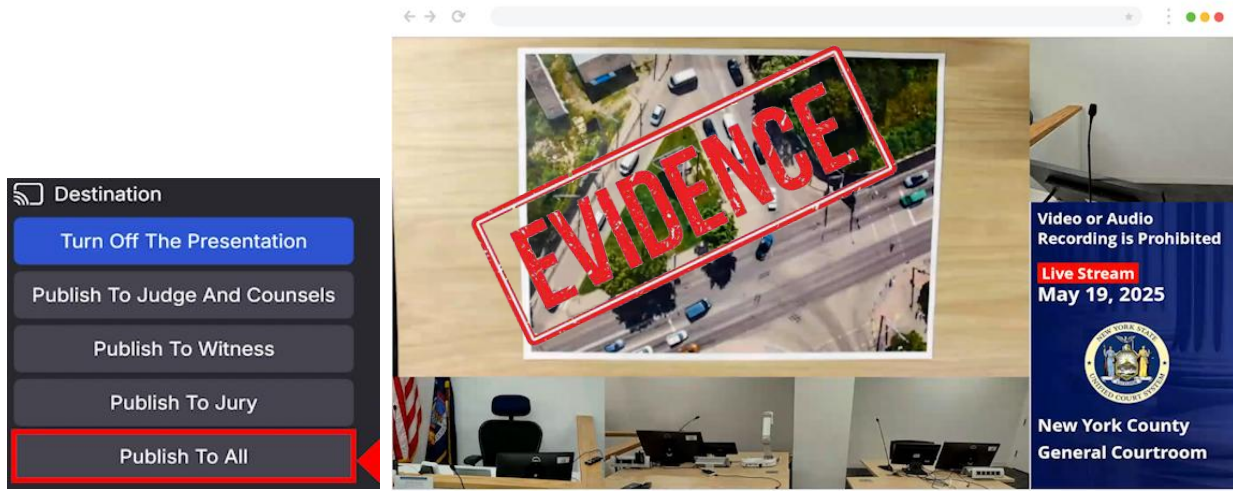
When the stream is live, the button will appear red, and a flashing border will display around the app interface.



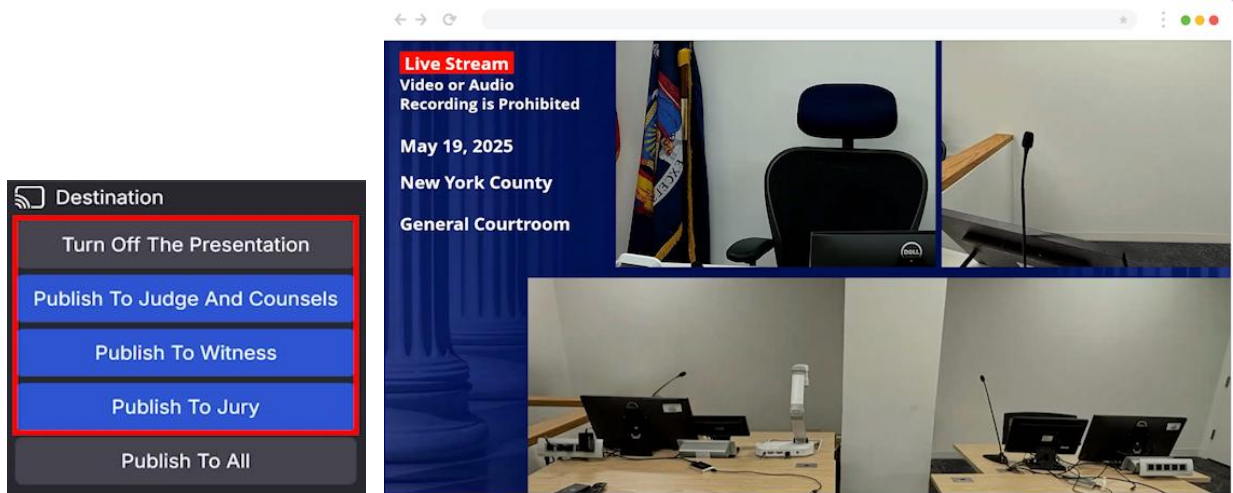
Once the stream is initiated from the control app, the viewer's screen will transition from the standby screen to the courtroom's default camera layout. This will also enable the transmission of audio from the courtroom microphones.



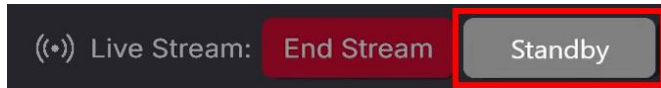
While evidence is being presented in the courtroom, selecting “**Publish to All**” in the control app will update the stream layout to include the evidence display and, if applicable, evidence audio.



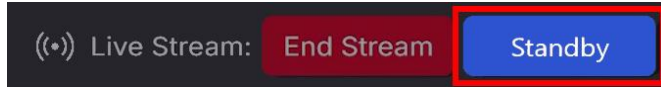
Changing to any of the other 4 destination options will automatically revert the stream layout to displaying the camera only layout.



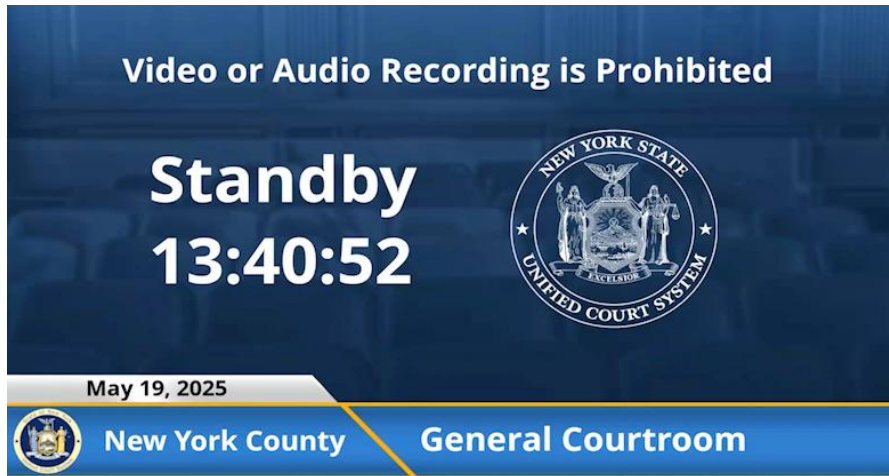
If at any time you need to pause the stream, click on the “Standby” button. This will stop the audio and video broadcast and display the standby screen to viewers.

- When you're ready, click the “Standby” button again to "un-pause" the stream, restoring both the audio and camera feed, and returning the view to the four-camera layout.

To end the stream, click the 'End Stream' button. The flashing border will disappear. And the stream will return to standby layout.
