

# OCA-DGCP-048 500 Patroon Creek Data Center

## *Initial Questions and Responses*

The New York State Unified Court System (UCS) thanks the vendors that submitted the questions below concerning the 500 Patroon Creek Data Center Request for Bid (RFB) issued on March 28, 2025.

Below are the responses to the questions UCS received in connection with this RFB as of April 4, 2025.

### **Question #1:**

I don't see any mention of fire suppression/sprinkler systems in the scope. Can you please confirm that fire suppression is excluded?

### **UCS Response:**

Fire suppression is excluded from the scope of the current RFB as it will be procured via a New York State Office of General Services centralized contract.

### **Question #2:**

Since the awarded designer is not eligible to submit a bid for the integration, are we able to get on the list of interested integrators for that scope of work when the time comes? Or, do you have a process for that?

### **UCS Response:**

At this point in time, the UCS is only soliciting bids for the design work of the datacenter. Once the RFB evaluation has been completed, UCS will discuss and evaluate options for integration in coordination with the Building's Landlord.

### **Question #3:**

Please send us an updated planholders/bidders list so we can update our database with the most current information available. Please also let us know if there are any changes to the bid date and please provide a construction cost estimate or budget range if available.

### **UCS Response:**

Administrative records may be requested through a Freedom of Information Law (FOIL) request. Any changes to bid dates will be posted on UCS's website and in the NYS Contract Reporter.
